

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1959  
PROPOSED DISPOSAL OF LAND AT KILMACOLM ROAD, GREENOCK.**

**Notice is hereby given** in terms of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1959 S.27 (2A) (as amended) that the Inverclyde Council proposes to dispose of land at Kilmacolm Road, Greenock extending to 0.063Ha (634.94sqm) or thereby forming part of an open space.

The proposal is that the land is sold to Reos Limited for market value. The prospective purchaser intends constructing a small retail development on this land plus additional adjacent land. The intention is to construct two blocks containing approximately seven units in total with onsite parking provision. Access will be taken from Kilmacolm Road.
