**GLENMOSSTON FLOOD PROTECTION SCHEME 2021**

On 23/04/2021 Inverclyde Council confirmed the Scheme without modification in terms of Paragraph 4(1) of Schedule 2 of the Act. The Scheme, which will come into operation on 11/06/2021, was advertised in the Greenock Telegraph, the Paisley Daily Express and the Edinburgh Gazette on 02/03/2021 and the effect of the Scheme is as stated.

Any person affected by the Scheme wishing to appeal against the validity of the Scheme or any provision contained in it on the grounds (a) that the Scheme breaches the restriction in sub-section (3) of Section 61 of the Act or does not comply with the requirement in sub-section (4) of that Section; (b) that in reaching the decision, the local authority has erred in law; or (c) that there was a failure to comply with a procedural requirement contained in the Scheme or any regulations made under it may, before the expiry of 6 weeks from the date of publication of this Notice make an appeal to the Sheriff Clerk, Greenock Sheriff Court, Nelson Street, Greenock.
