If refuse collections are delayed due to adverse weather, please put your containers out by 7 am each day to allow collection at the earliest opportunity.

Guidance on what can be recycled

<p>The following materials can be recycled using your BLUE recycling container (please rinse clean):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Food & Drinks Cans ✓ Cardboard ✓ Paper (newspapers, magazines, catalogues, telephone directories, yellow pages, un-shredded office quality paper, envelopes, window envelopes - plastic film removed) ✓ Plastic Bottles (all types of drinks bottles, detergent bottles, cosmetics bottles) ✓ Plastic Food Containers (margarine tubs, yoghurt pots, fruit punnets, clear & coloured plastic food trays) ✓ Aluminium (foil & containers) ✓ Food & Drink Cartons 	<p>The following materials can be recycled using your GREEN food waste container:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ All dairy products (cheese, yoghurt etc.) ✓ Eggs (raw and cooked, including shells) ✓ Meat & Fish (raw and cooked, including bones) ✓ Fruit & Vegetables (including peelings) ✓ Bread, Cakes & Pastries ✓ Rice, Pasta & Beans ✓ Tea Bags & Coffee Grounds ✓ Out of date food (loose or still in packaging)
<p>The following garden waste can be recycled using your BROWN recycling container:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Hedge Trimmings ✓ Grass Cuttings ✓ Flowers, Plants & Weeds ✓ Leaves ✓ Twigs <p><u>A permit is required for the collection of each brown bin</u> Garden waste collections take place between March and November</p>	<p>You may use your black box to take your glass to your nearest recycling point or Recycling Centre</p>
<p>Please DO NOT use plastic bags in your recycling containers.</p> <p>It is important that only the correct materials go into your recycling containers. Any containers contaminated with the wrong materials will not be collected. A sticker will be left explaining why your container was not collected and what to do. Your container will then be collected on your next recycling collection day.</p> <p>Please place the appropriate container at your usual collection point by 7am and remove it as quickly as possible after collection.</p> <p>NOTE: Excess waste left on or beside your container will not be collected.</p> <p>For further information or to buy a garden waste permit visit www.inverclyde.gov.uk/recycling.</p>
