Your **BLACK** containers will be collected on the alternating week. Your **FOOD WASTE** container will be collected **EVERY FORTNIGHT** on the same day as your black bin. If refuse collections are delayed due to adverse weather, please put your containers out by 7 am each day to allow collection at the earliest opportunity.





## Guidance on what can be recycled

The following materials can be recycled using your The following materials can be recycled using your BLUE recycling container (please rinse clean): **GREEN** food waste container: Food & Drinks Cans Cardboard All dairy products (cheese, voghurt etc.) Eggs (raw and cooked, including shells ) Paper (newspapers, magazines, catalogues, telephone directories, yellow pages, un-shredded office quality paper, envelopes, Meat & Fish (raw and cooked, including bones) Fruit & Vegetables (including peelings) window envelopes - plastic film removed) Plastic Bottles (all types of drinks bottles, detergent bottles, **Bread, Cakes & Pastries** cosmetics bottles) Rice, Pasta & Beans Tea Bags & Coffee Grounds ✓ Plastic Food Containers (margarine tubs, yoghurt pots, fruit punnets, clear & coloured plastic food trays) Out of date food (loose or still in packaging) ✓ Aluminium (foil & containers) Food waste is collected fortnightly on the same day as your black bin. √ Food & Drink Cartons The following garden waste can be recycled using your You may use your black box to take your glass to your nearest recycling point **BROWN** recycling container: or Recycling Centre **Hedge Trimmings** Leaves **Grass Cuttings** √ Twigs Flowers, Plants & Weeds A permit is required for the collection of each brown bin Garden waste collections take place between March and November

Please **DO NOT** use plastic bags in your recycling containers.

It is important that only the correct materials go into your recycling containers. Any containers contaminated with the wrong materials will not be collected. A sticker will be left explaining why your container was not collected and what to do. Your container will then be collected on your next recycling collection day.

Please place the appropriate container at your usual collection point by 7am and remove it as quickly as possible after collection.

**NOTE:** Excess waste left on or beside your container will not be collected.
