Ms Sinclair advised that there are no objections or representations to the application.

Ms Caroline Loudon addressed the Board providing information on refurbishment to the premises and the increase in alcohol capacity. She advised of administration updates to the activities to bring the licence in line with other licences held by the Company.

There being no comments from any other parties, Councillor Brooks moved grant of the application which was unanimously agreed.

Mr Seamus Lamb, Messrs Maitlands LLP, was present representing the application. Mr Pervinder Dhési, family member was in attendance.

Ms Sinclair advised that Police Scotland had submitted an objection to the application, and thereafter read the contents of the Chief Superintendent's letter to the Board, copies of which had previously been circulated to Members.

Mr Lamb addressed the Board on the application in detail in relation to the significant entertainment facilities taking place within the premises. In particular, he outlined that there is a Disco every Saturday night with a DJ and four Stewards. Mr P Dhési stated that there are two DJs rather than one. Mr Lamb advised that during the festive season when an extension is provided to 2.00 a.m. there have been no reports of any noise or nuisance. He also stated that the granting of an extension would not create a precedence as there are no other similar premises in the area. Mr Lamb advised that the entertainment being provided is significant and requested Members to consider the application favourably.

Sergeant Trutwin re-iterated the terms of the Police Scotland objection highlighting issues of violence and disorder in late evening and early hours.

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In response to a question from Councillor McVey, Mr Lamb confirmed that the outdoor area does not form part of the application.

Following a private hearing, Councillor Brooks moved grant of the application, and as an amendment, Councillor McVey moved refusal on the ground the application is out with the Board's Policy. On a vote, three Members (Councillors McVey, McCormick and Robertson) voted for the amendment and five Members (Councillors Brooks, Cassidy, Jackson, Law and Reynolds) voted for the motion which was declared carried.

Ms Sinclair confirmed the application as granted.

**LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005  
REVIEW OF LICENSING BOARD POLICY STATEMENT**

Ms Sinclair addressed the Board on the terms of the report providing an update following the joint meeting of the Licensing Board and the Local Licensing Forum on 1 August 2023, and requested that the Board now consider what revisions require to be made to the existing Licensing Board Policy Statement in Appendix 7 to the report, prior to the next public consultation. All documentation had been forwarded to Members prior to the meeting giving them the opportunity to consider the information provided and the proposed draft amendments to the existing Policy Statement.

The Chair addressed the Board commenting that this was a comprehensive review and asked what form the further consultation would take. Ms Sinclair explained that the further consultation process would be similar to the initial consultation and that a further report would be brought to the Board for consideration in light of any responses.

The Chair asked Sergeant Robertson if he had any comments he wished to make and also opened the meeting for Members to ask any questions to those in attendance.

Councillor Robertson thanked those persons/organisations who had provided feedback and contributed thus far.

Councillor McVey made reference to the Board's Outdoor Policy, moving that there shall be no consumption of alcohol in any outdoor area after 9pm, albeit every application be considered on its own merits. Councillor McVey moved a terminal hour of 9pm for outdoor drinking, which was unanimously agreed by the Board.

Councillor McVey also asked Mr Brown, Licensing Standards Officer, what checks were carried out to ensure that alcohol deliveries were accompanied by food. Mr Brown, advised that no specific checks were carried out and Ms Dillon, Public Protection Manager, stated that it would be very challenging to police daily deliveries to private residences, however she was not aware of any complaints locally and there is no evidence to suggest a problem with delivery to persons who are underage.

Councillor Cassidy stated that residents have raised concerns about an issue at Inverkip Beach and other areas. He stated that he would like to see a condition that alcohol delivery only be permitted with food, unless an off sales premises. Councillor Cassidy moved that such

a condition be included within the Policy Statement. There was no amendment, and the motion was unanimously agreed.

The Board also considered the proposed revision to the Policy Statement in relation to the “ Safe Home “ initiatives for staff who work late at night and unanimously agreed that the proposed sections be incorporated within the Policy Statement.

Thereafter, the Board considered proposed revisions in relation to the following key areas:

### **Curfew**

Ms Sinclair addressed the Board highlighting a key change to the existing Policy Statement with regard to the proposed withdrawal of the 12 midnight curfew following a consultation which included Police Scotland. Councillor Robertson stated that as discussed at the Joint Licensing Board/Licensing Forum meeting, there is no evidence to support retaining the curfew. Members unanimously agreed that wording should be inserted in the Policy Statement at the relevant section to reflect that this decision was unanimously made by the Board after careful consideration of the evidence from Police Scotland and other consultees.

### **Children & Young Persons**

Ms Sinclair highlighted that a draft revision has been made to the Policy Statement to reflect a key proposed change, as previously requested by the Board, that a young person (a person 16 and 17 years of age) can be within a restaurant until 11pm unaccompanied by an adult, while having a meal.

Councillor Robertson commented that considering young persons separately from children was a positive cultural shift.

### **Overprovision**

Ms Sinclair addressed the Board, advising that the Board requires to determine whether there is overprovision in relation to any of the 17 Localities, previously determined by the Board at its meeting on 28 June 2023.

Councillor Robertson considered it would be helpful to have further information available before determining overprovision. Councillor McVey expressed concern about the Inverclyde alcohol related deaths and hospital admissions. He agreed with Councillor Robertson that it was important to consult as robustly as possible and that a separate consultation should be undertaken, in 6 to 12 months time with a further report to the Board. All Board Members unanimously agreed with this approach.

Decided:

- (1) that the further changes as agreed now be made to the existing Licensing board Policy Statement;
- (2) that the Clerk of the Board be authorised to make the necessary changes to the existing Licensing Board Policy Statement and publicise the amended Policy as part of a further consultation with a further report being brought to the Board prior to 4 November 2023, on the outcome of the consultation;
- (3) that the Clerk of the Board be authorised to undertake a separate consultation six to twelve months from now, in relation to the issue of overprovision.

**LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005  
LICENSING BOARD POLICY CONSULTATION**

Ms Sinclair addressed the Board on the outcome of the public consultation in relation to review of the Licensing Board's Policy Statement which has been considered by the Board at meetings on 26 June, 1 August, and 18 September 2023, and requested that the Board now consider what further revisions, if any, require to be made to the Licensing Board Policy Statement.

Ms Sinclair advised there has been one response to the public consultation which closed on 24 October 2023, a response from a Gourock Premises Licence Holder, objecting to the proposed withdrawal of the 12 midnight Curfew.

Ms Sinclair requested that Members consider a minor amendment to the section of the Policy Statement regarding Delegated Authority and note that the Scheme of Delegation had been approved by the Board in June 2022, not 2023. Separately, Ms Sinclair proposed that the additional delegated authority granted to the Clerk/Depute Clerk in relation to Extended Hours/Occasional Licence applications, only apply in circumstances where it is not reasonably practical to hold a hearing. Cllr Brooks moved grant to amend the Policy Statement by insertion of the words "in circumstances where it is not reasonably practical to hold a hearing".

Cllr Reynolds addressed the Board on recent changes to legislation in relation to vaping, however as Officers have not had an opportunity to consider any changes, Cllr Reynolds did not insist upon any change to the Policy Statement at this time.

Ms Sinclair also highlighted that whilst some changes to the Policy will take immediate effect, such as withdrawal of the Curfew, others will not. Premises Licence Holders will require to carefully check the terms of their Operating Plans or contact the Licensing Section to make enquiries and ascertain if an application for variation is necessary.

It was noted that at the Board's meeting on 18 September 2023, the Board was of the view there was insufficient information available in order to assess overprovision in any of its 17 locality areas. The Clerk of the Board was authorised to undertake a further consultation specifically in relation to overprovision with the outcome of the consultation to be considered at a future meeting of the Board.

There followed a full discussion between all parties on the issues raised.

Cllr Brooks moved that the Policy Statement set out in Appendix 1, as amended, now be approved and adopted with effect from 1 November 2023 with the other recommendations of the report also approved. There was no amendment to this motion, which was unanimously granted.

Decision:

- (a) agreed that in terms of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 there is no overprovision policy, as at the date of this policy statement, in relation to licensed premises within the 17 localities within the Board's area, but that further research and consultation on overprovision will be conducted by Officers and reported to a further meeting of the Board;
- (b) that the Licensing Board Policy Statement as set out in Appendix 1, and with such further changes as agreed by the Board at this meeting, be approved and adopted, such adoption being with effect from 1 November 2023;
- (c) agree to grant delegated authority to the Clerk and the Depute Clerk of the Licensing Board, in consultation with the Chair of the Board, to make such further changes as are deemed necessary further to the Board's decision today, and thereafter to finalise and publish the Licensing Board Policy Statement.

#### **LICENSING BOARD FESTIVE SEASON POLICY 2023 – 2024**

There was submitted a report by the Clerk of the Board on the proposed terms of the Festive Season Policy 2023 – 2024.

Ms Sinclair advised that the proposed Policy has been based on the Board's previous Festive Season Policies and that only events which relate to the festive season are applicable. She confirmed that the curfew will be deleted from the Policy following the updated Licensing Board Policy which comes into effect on 1 November 2023.

The Chair moved grant of the Policy as amended which was unanimously agreed.

Decided:

- (a) that 'blanket' extensions under section 67 of the Act for licensed premises (except Off Sales) shall be permitted;
- (b) that the Festive Season Policy will cover the period from Friday 8 December 2023 to Monday 1 January 2024 inclusive;
- (c) that licensed premises (except nightclubs) may open until 1.00 a.m. on Sunday to Wednesday and 2.00 a.m. Thursday to Saturday and nightclubs may open until 2.00 a.m. on Sunday to Wednesday and 3.30 a.m. (Bar to close 3.00 a.m.) on Thursday to Saturday;

- (d) that the terminal hour on Sunday 24 December, Monday 25 December, Tuesday 26 December and Sunday 31 December 2023 and Monday 1 January 2024 has the same terminal hour as Thursday to Saturday;
- (e) that the event being held must relate to the festive season e.g. Christmas Party Night, Hogmanay, and not to Birthday Parties, Weddings etc.;
- (f) that the curfew is deleted;
- (g) that to assist the administration process, licence holders should notify the Police Scotland Licensing Department as soon as possible of those dates within the Festive Season Policy they intend to utilise; and
- (h) that occasional licence applications made for non-licensed premises e.g. Greenock Town Hall, Gamble Halls, Port Glasgow Town Hall, Community Halls etc for an event within the festive period may have the same hours granted in terms of the Festive Season Policy for events solely related to festive activities.

Mr Brian McMahon, McMahon Consultancy was present representing the applicant together with Mr Lee, Licence Holder and Mr Kumar, designated premises manager.

Ms Sinclair advised that Police Scotland had submitted a representation by letter dated 26 July 2023 which she read to the Board. The Police Scotland representation included a request for additional conditions to be added to the licence, if granted. Ms Sinclair also advised that a letter of objection dated 26 July 2023 had been received from Health and Social Care Partnership and she read the terms of their objection to the Board.

Sergeant Robertson confirmed he had no further comments and that the conditions requested are standard conditions to most home delivery services.

The Licensing Standards Officer confirmed no comments to the application.

				<p>Mr McMahon addressed the Board providing information on the home delivery service to be provided, he confirmed that alcohol will only be delivered with a minimum of a £10 food order. In respect of the Police Conditions, he stated that his client was content to accept the proposed Conditions, apart from the condition relating to mandatory training of delivery drivers as in future his clients may wish to use third parties. He advised that it would be more appropriate that staff receive relevant training, and that the proposed 2 hour training is restrictive and punitive in nature, and could be subject to legal challenge.</p> <p>Sergeant Robertson said he was satisfied with the proposed amendment to the Condition that there is a safe and responsible delivery of alcohol.
