STATEMENT OF LOCAL TOTALS FOR THE COUNTING OFFICER'S AREA

I, **JOHN W MUNDELL**, Counting Officer appointed for the Inverclyde Council local government area at the Scottish Independence Referendum, held on 18 September 2014, hereby certify and declare:

1. The total number of ballot papers counted in the referendum in the Inverclyde Council area is

FIFTY FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND ONE (54,601)

The turnout is

87.4%.

2. The total number of votes cast in relation to each answer to the referendum question in this area is as follows:
