Children and Young People's Rights

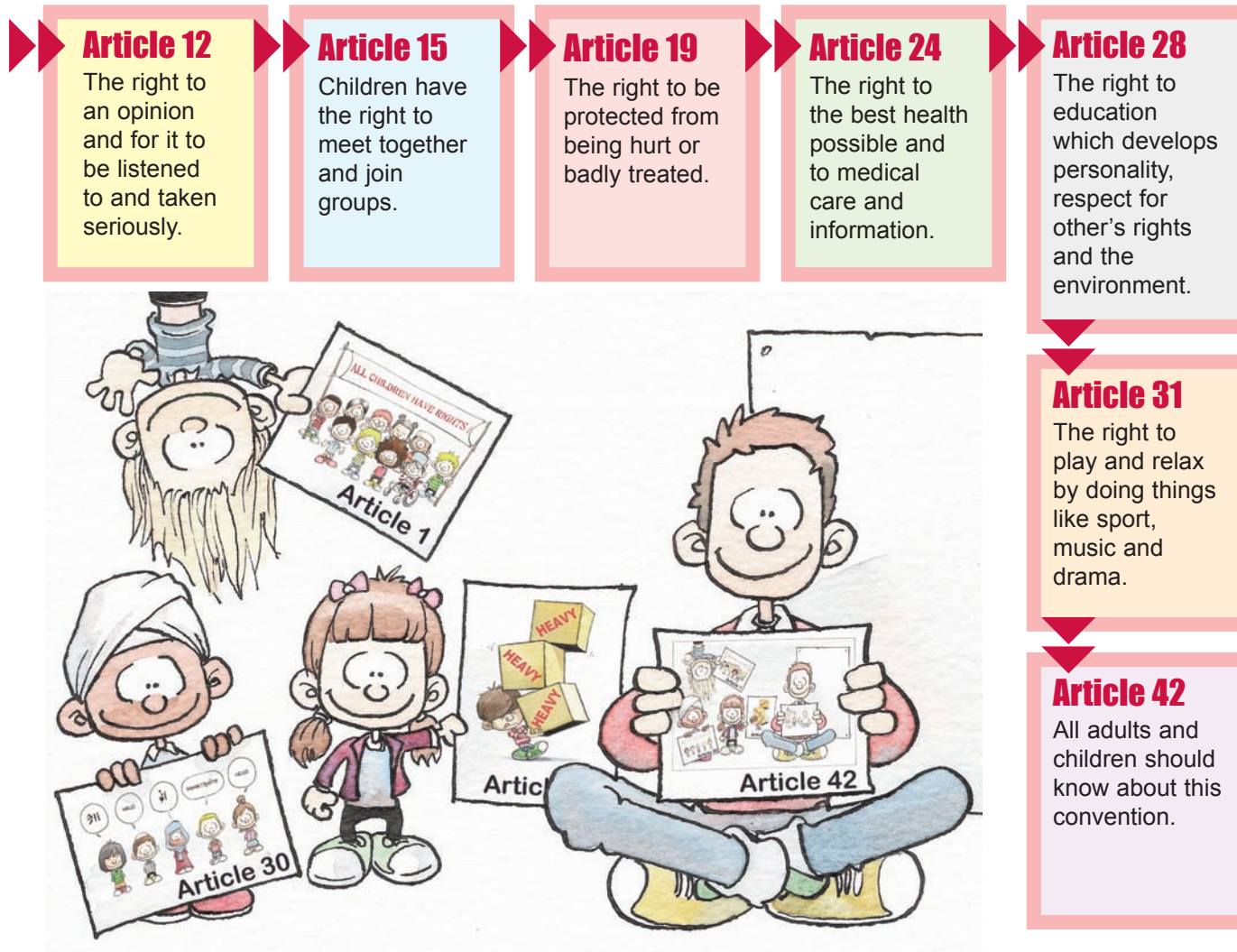
All Children and Young People under the age of 18 have rights.
