- 6. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom.
- 7. Applications for postal votes, or amendments or cancellations of postal votes, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Renfrewshire Valuation Joint Board by 5pm on Tuesday 19 April 2016.
- 8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Renfrewshire Valuation Joint Board by 5pm on Tuesday 26 April 2016.
- 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Renfrewshire Valuation Joint Board, The Robertson Centre, 16 Glasgow Road, Paisley PA1 3QF by 5pm on Thursday 5 May 2016. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Tuesday 26 April 2016. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Tuesday 26 April 2016.
