## 1800-1825

This index covers birth, marriage and death notices that appeared in newspapers in the Greenock and Port Glasgow area from 1800 until 1825. It is provided to researchers as a reference resource to aid the searching of these historic publications which can be consulted on microfiche, preferably by prior appointment, at the Watt Library, 9 Union Street, Greenock.

Records are indexed by type: birth, death and marriage, then by year in chronological order followed by surnames in alphabetical order. Marriage records are listed by year and the surnames, in alphabetical order, of the spouses.
