Cardboard



- Food and drink cartons
 - Juice cartons
 - Milk cartons
 - Soup cartons
 - Cereal boxes
 - Toilet roll and kitchen roll tubes
 - Cardboard packaging
- Please rinse cartons thoroughly



Mixed plastics



Coloured and clear food trays

Milk bottles, including lids

Plastic cosmetic bottles, including lids

Plastic cleaning product bottles

Please empty, remove any cling film or netting and rinse items thoroughly

Please rinse containers thoroughly



The following items **should not** be placed in your blue bin:

Plastic bags or cellophane

Glass bottles or jars

Food waste

Old clothing
