LATE HOURS CATERING LICENCE STANDARD CONDITIONS

1. The hours of business permitted under this Licence are as follows:-

(Trading Hours)

- 2. The Licence Holder must arrange facilities for the disposal of litter outwith the premises to the satisfaction of the Council's Head of Safer and Inclusive Communities.
- 3. The Licence Holder must modulate any noise (including amplified music) within the premises to the satisfaction of the Council and must apply with all instructions made by the Council's Head of Legal & Property Services, Head of Safer & Inclusive Communities or other Authorised Officers with a view to minimising or avoiding nuisance or annoyance to the general public.
- 4. All requirements of the Scottish Fire & Rescue Service relating to fire precautions and safety at the premises must be carried out and maintained by the Licence Holder.
- 5. The Licence Holder must not alter or deface the Licence in any way.
- 6. It is understood that the Licence Holder is not bound to keep his premises open during the times set out in this licence.
- 7. This Licence must be kept on public display within the premises during the hours specified in this licence.
- 8. The Licence Holder shall inform the Council of any change of address, whether permanent or temporary, as shown in this Licence within 7 days of such change of address: any change of address intimated to the Council shall not be treated as a Variation of Licence and the Licence shall be amended at the cost of the Council.
