They had two children.

"On Friday night or Saturday morning the shop of Mr Patrick Devlin, watchmaker, situated in William Street, Greenock, Greenock, was entered by thieves, and no fewer than sixty-four watches, seven of them which were of

gold, carried off, besides a quantity of jewellery, the extent of which has not yet been ascertained. There were also taken three American eagles (gold), one old guinea, a sovereign and a half, and about thirty ounces of dollars and old coins. The value of the watches alone is about 500. No trace of the thieves had been obtained up to Saturday night.

"We noted some time ago that a jeweller's shop was broken into in Greenock and gold and silver watches carried away to the value of 500. In consequence of information communicated to the Carlisle Police, they succeeded in taking into custody a broker from Glasgow who was attempting to dispose of some of the stolen watches. Upwards of twenty were found in his possession, and the prisoner and property were brought to Glasgow by Mr Mann, Superintendent of the Greenock Police." *Edinburgh Evening Post* 25th July 1848.

"In our report of the Back Wynd murder in Thursday's impression, one of the witnesses gave his designation as, James Gardner, Jeweller, Greenock. We understand his distinctive address is James Gardner, Working Jeweller, William Street, Greenock. Glasgow Herald" - 28th April 1860

James Gardner was born in Paisley circa 1831 and by 1841 was living in Greenock. The 1861 census records him living in Union Street, Greenock as a watchmaker employing three men and a boy. Edinburgh Assay Office lists him as a watch and clockmaker, jeweller and silversmith in Greenock from 1858-1867.

There was stolen out of a house in Port Glasgow, a watch with a tortoise-shell outer case, having the figure of Hope leaning on an anchor and pointing to a ship, painted on the back. The inner case was silver, and the maker's name, Churchill, London, No. 7730. Whoever can give any information of the said watch will please apply to Mr John Heron, watchmaker, Greenock." Glasgow Courier, 13th May 1797.</i></p>

Duncan McGregor started his business in Greenock in 1836 and opened premises in Glasgow in 1844. He traded as D. He was listed in 1871 as a watch maker employing 1 man and two apprentices, living with his brother Lophron at 17 West Blackhall Street, Greenock. His business continued at 49 Brougham Street, Greenock in 1881 but then expanded into the wine trade and is listed as a spirit dealer in Greenock by 1891.
