LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 FESTIVE SEASON POLICY 2017-2018

The Board considered a report by the Depute Clerk to determine the 2017-2018 Festive Season Policy with regard to extended hours of Premises Licences and Occasional Licence applications.

Mr Douglas advised the Board that the report is in similar terms to last year's policy years and Police Scotland have intimated they have no objections to a similar Policy being adopted this year.

After discussion Councillor Ahlfeld moved grant of the proposals which were granted.

The Board agreed the 2017-2018 Festive Policy as follows:-

- (a) blanket' extension across Inverclyde in terms of Section 67 of the Act;
- (b) to cover the period Friday 1 December 2017 to Tuesday 2 January 2018 inclusive;
- (c) the terminal hour for licensed premises as follows:-

Premises Licences (except Nightclubs)

Sunday – Wednesday 1.00 am
Thursday – Saturday 2.00 am

Premises Licences (Nightclubs)

Sunday to Wednesday 2.00am
Thursday to Saturday 3.30am
(Bar to close 3.00am)

- (d) the event held must relate to the festive season e.g. Christmas Party Night, Hogmanay;
- (e) the curfew be relaxed to 1.00 a.m. on the evening of 31 December 2017 in to 1 January 2017;
- (f) licence holders are asked to notify Police Scotland of the days and hours they wish to uptake within the Policy period by 24 November 2017 if possible; and
- (g) an occasional licence application for festive events being held in non-licensed premises must comply with the Policy in the event that the extended hours available are not sought.

Mr Douglas advised that the Board's Policy for Sunday morning opening has the condition that any alcohol sold on a Sunday must be ancillary to a sit down table meal and no vertical drinking is permitted until 12.15 p.m.

The Board heard Mr Dunn in support of the application. After discussion, Mr Douglas advised the Board that Mr Dunn will amend his application by removal of the on sales hours applied for on Saturday and Sunday in line with the Board's Policy.

Councillor Ahlfeld moved grant of the application as amended which was agreed.
