PRE APPLICATION SCREENING NOTICE

The submission of a pre-application screening notice is optional. It is for instances where the applicant is uncertain whether their proposal falls in to one of the types of development categorised as either National or Major. The planning authority has 21 days to respond to the notice and advise whether the proposal requires pre application consultation.
