



# Chapelton Bridge Port Glasgow

**We will be carrying out work soon to widen Chapelton Bridge in Port Glasgow**

This will improve the pedestrian route to St John's Primary School for pupils and parents by creating two pavements each 2m wide.

The works will widen the road to provide two lanes of traffic across the bridge.

# Bridge widening at **Chapelton Bridge** in Port Glasgow

The work will be carried out in two phases:

**Phase 1** Utilities including water, gas and electricity need to be diverted to the north side of the bridge to allow the widening work to take place

**Phase 2** Widening of the bridge and improvements to the pavement and road

Because of the narrow width of the bridge, it will not be possible to keep it open while the work takes place. An alternative pedestrian route will be provided.

<b>When does it start:</b>	Monday 19 November 2018	February 2019
<b>When does it finish:</b>	Friday 21 December 2018	May 2019
<b>Which roads are affected:</b>	Chapelton Bridge, Port Glasgow Glenpark Drive to the junction of Rossbank Road, Port Glasgow	
<b>Diversion route:</b>	A fully signed diversion will be in place throughout. Lilybank Road, Birkmyre Avenue, Farquahar Road, Mitchell Street Lansbury Street, Gibshill Road, Port Glasgow Road A8, Brown Street Balfour Street, Glen Avenue, Alderwood Road and Glenpark Drive (and vice versa)
