What we're building

BAM is managing the construction of the new Greenock Health and Care Centre at 26 Wellington Street, Greenock PA15 4NG.

It is a New build Health & Care Centre project delivered through the Hub West Scotland framework with a value of approximately £21 million.

The project is due to commence on the 21st Jan 2019 for a period of 83 weeks. Principle activities on the project will involve bulk earthworks to the main site and North Car park, substructure, superstructure and envelope / roofing works. This will be followed by internal fit-out works to the building. Externally it incorporates car parking, soft landscaping and a landscaped courtyard to the building.

Services based at the new state-of-the-art centre will

include four GP practices, a community hub, dentistry, podiatry, physiotherapy, sexual health, treatment rooms, district nursing, health visiting, school nursing, home care teams, child and adolescent mental health, speech and language therapy, out-patient clinics and a cafe.

Cllr Moran said: "The new centre will aim to provide modern health and social care premises, and will expand

the range of services available.
