Exhibit Labels - The correct category label must be **attached to all entries**.

Please read the Section information carefully. Where multiple entries are allowed, the more entries you have (up to the maximum number stated) the more points you may earn.

Entry Forms - An entry form, listing all exhibitors, should accompany entries.

If you are a school or organisation it is important that you arrange a representative to be there on the day, to accept any trophy you may be awarded. This could be a pupil, parent or anyone able to attend on your behalf. The awards are given at approx. 2.45pm.

Playgroups and Nurseries

Categories 1- 7 Each organisation can submit up to 3 entries in each category.

You can submit:

1. One bowl of Hyacinths
2. One bowl of Daffodils or Narcissus
3. One bowl of Tulips
4. One bowl of any other Bulbous Plant
5. One Foliage or Flowering Plant
6. One Collage depicting Summer using only Natural Materials (A3 size)
7. Handicrafts e.g. jewellery, hand crafted cards etc

SECTION B – THE PETER BORTHWICK TROPHY

Competition for Each School - Individual Pupils Competing

Categories 8 -15 Each pupil can submit up to 3 entries into each category

You can submit:

8. One bowl of Hyacinths
9. One bowl of Daffodils or Narcissus
10. One bowl of Tulips
11. One Foliage or Flowering Plant
12. One bowl of any other Bulbous Plant
13. One Decorative Bowl
14. Handicrafts e.g. jewellery, hand crafted cards etc
15. Inverclyde has thousands of tourists visiting every year on cruise ships – can you draw or paint or design a poster welcoming tourists to the area.

SECTION C – THE HENRY LITHGOW TROPHY

Inter Schools Competition

Categories 16 – 19 Each school can submit up to 3 entries in each category.

You can submit:

16. One bowl of Hyacinths
17. One bowl of Daffodils or Narcissus
18. One bowl of Tulips
19. One bowl of any other Bulbous Plants

SECTION D – THE LADY JEAN STEVENSON TROPHY

Primary Schools - entries are a maximum of 20 per school and should be A4.

Playgroups and Nurseries - entries will be restricted to a max of 20 per organisation and should be A4

SECTION F – THE PROVOST GC BROWNLEE TROPHY

Junior Organisations and after School Clubs 5-11 years

Categories 22 - 29 Organisations can submit up to 3 entries into each category

You can submit:

22. One bowl of Hyacinths
23. One bowl of Daffodils or Narcissus
24. One bowl of Tulips
25. One bowl of any other Bulbous Plant.
26. One Foliage or Flowering Plant.
27. One Collage – Subject of Own Choice (A3).
28. Handicrafts e.g. jewellery, hand crafted cards etc
29. The River Clyde is a hive of activity every day. Draw or paint a picture showing some of the on the water activities; the ferries, the submarines or even the kayaking. Entries are a maximum of 20 per organisation and must be A3.

SECTION G – THE INVERCLYDE COUNCIL SHIELD

Junior Organisations 12-18 years

Categories 30 – 37 Organisations can submit up to 3 entries in each category

You can submit:

30. One bowl of Hyacinths
31. One bowl of Daffodils or Narcissus
32. One bowl of Tulips.
33. One bowl of any other Bulbous Plant.
34. One Foliage or Flowering Plant.
35. One Display of Pressed Flowers.
36. Handicrafts e.g. jewellery, hand crafted cards etc

SECTION H – THE NEWARK SHIELD

Individual School Pupils – up to a maximum of 20 entries per school

Junior Organisations and After School Clubs 5 – 11 Years – up to a maximum of 20 per organisation

SECTION J – THE CATHIE ALLAN MEMORIAL SHIELD

Junior Organisations 12 – 18 Years - entries will be restricted to a max of 20 per organisation

You can submit:

40. One Buttonhole / Spray of Flowers

SECTION K – THE INVERCLYDE DISTRICT COUNCIL SHIELD

Open to All Inverclyde Residents

Categories 41 – 48 One entry per person is allowed in each category

You can submit:

- 41. One bowl Hyacinths
- 42. One bowl of Daffodils or Narcissus
- 43. One bowl of Tulips.
- 44. One Foliage or Flowering Plant.
- 45. One bowl of any other Bulbous Plant.
- 46. One Decorative Bowl or Basket.
- 47. One Cactus bowl/Succulent.
- 48. Handicrafts e.g. Jewellery, hand crafted cards etc

SECTION L – BURGH OF PORT GLASGOW CUP

Senior Citizens' Organisations

Categories 49 – 56. Each organisation can submit up to 3 entries in each category

You can submit:

- 49. One bowl of Hyacinths
- 50. One bowl of Daffodils or Narcissus
- 51. One bowl of Tulips
- 52. One Foliage or Flowering Plant.
- 53. One bowl of any other Bulbous Plant.
- 54. One Decorative bowl.

- 55. One Cactus bowl/Succulent
- 56. Handicrafts e.g. jewellery, hand crafted cards etc

SECTION M – CORONATION PARK TROPHY

Open to Individuals and Organisations – One entry per person

You can submit:

- 57. Floral arrangement of your own choice of natural materials preferred, although synthetic materials are also acceptable.

SECTION N –THE COMET TROPHY for BULB SHOW BAKE OFF

Open to Individuals (amateur bakers only) and Organisations

Categories 58-61 Individuals can submit 1 entry into each category.
Organisations can submit 3 entries in each category.

You can submit:

- 58. Sweet bakes:
You can enter a sponge cake x 1 or cupcakes x 3 or scones x 3
- 59. Biscuits & Tray-bakes:
This category includes any tray-bake, biscuit (including shortbread) and tablet. Please submit 3 pieces of your entry.
- 60. Savoury bakes:
You can enter anything savoury including but not limited to bread, scones, pies or quiche.
- 61. Showstopper:
Your chance to show off your baking skills to the judges – anything goes!
