Subject: Capital Programme 2008/11 - Progress

### 1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 Purpose of the report is to update the Committee in respect of the status of the projects forming the Education Capital Programme and to highlight the overall financial position.

### 2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 This report advises Committee in respect of the progress and financial status of the projects within the overall Education Capital Programme.
- 2.2 The Capital Programme has been revised to reflect the new School Estate Strategy approved by the Committee and the full Council at their meetings of 18 June 2008. Adjustments have also been made to reflect the decisions of the Policy and Resources Executive Sub Committee on 25 June 2008.
- 2.3 Overall the Committee is projecting to contain the costs of the 2008/11 Capital Programme within available budgets.
- 2.4 Appendix 1 contains details of the projected spend and cashflow for the Capital Programme over the 3 years of the current programme.

### 3.0 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 That the Committee note the progress on the specific projects detailed in Appendix 1.

#### 4.0 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 This report shows the current position of the approved Education Capital Programme reflecting the allocation of resources approved by the Committee and the Council at the special meetings on 18 June 2008. This allocation forms the basis of the School Estate Programme to completion.
- 4.2 The School Estate Strategy approved by the Committee gives a comprehensive programme which will enable the Council's entire school stock to be modernised. The programme runs for more than 12 years. The Education Capital Programme detailed in this report show details of projects which will incur expenditure up to March 2011

### 5.0 PPP SCHOOLS PROJECTS

- 5.1 Although they do not form part of the Capital Programme the four PPP schools are a significant part of the School Estate Management Plan and it is appropriate to report on the progress of building works in this report.
- 5.2 All Saints' Primary is progressing well and in accordance with the programme. The spine retaining wall and foundations have been completed, as has the steel frame. The decking to the upper floor has commenced and the precast concrete stairs will be installed imminently. The underslab drainage is progressing well which will enable the ground floor slab to be poured on programme. The next key activities due to start include the installation of the roof, substructure brick and block and the road works out with the site boundary.
- 5.3 Aileymill Primary is progressing well and in accordance with the programme. The steel frame has been completed, the precast concrete stairs have been installed and the roof installation has commenced. The upper floor slabs have also been poured. The underslab drainage is progressing well which will enable the ground floor slab to commence. Work has also commenced to the externals with the installation of the kerbs to the car park. The next key activities due to start include the external brick and block and the site fixed framing system (SFS).
- 5.4 The new substation has now been installed at Notre Dame with conclusion of the legal wayleaves awaited. It is intended to commission the substation in advance of the main contract works starting. Progress at Notre Dame is in accordance with the programme. It is planned to decant the School from the Notre Dame building in the first week in June and for the contractor to take possession of the site at the beginning of July, slightly ahead of programme. The decant arrangements and refurbishment works to the former Wellington Academy building are on programme.
- 5.5 It is planned to decant St Columba's High School to the former Greenock High School building in the third week in June and for the contractor to take possession of the site at the beginning of July, in line with the programme. The decant arrangements and refurbishment works to the former Greenock High School Building are on programme.

#### 6.0 EASTER HOLIDAY WORKS

6.1 As part of the Capital and Maintenance Programmes a number of projects have been progressed over the Easter holiday period as summarised below:

## St John's PS

- Playground resurfaced two areas
- Redecoration of all corridors and stairwells.

- Fire doors upgraded and new doors installed
- Render work two areas

## Lady Alice PS

- Infant playground resurfaced
- Ground floor corridor floor coverings replaced

#### Moorfoot PS

- Car park extended additional 16 parking places
- Lower corridor floor coverings replaced

### Lilybank

New partitions installed as recommended by HMIe

## St Stephen's HS

- PE Blocks refurbished
- · Redecoration of assembly hall

### Wellington Acad/NDHS

• Extensive work on-going to prepare for NDHS

### Greenock HS/St Columba's

Extensive work on-going to prepare for St Columba's

#### 7.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 7.1 The spend at 31 March 2009 is £15.388M, from an approved budget of £17.370M. This is expenditure of 89% of the budget after 100% of the year. It should be noted however that this is a provisional position subject to the year end accounting process. The estimated expenditure for 08/09 is £16,175M, 7% less than the original projection. This has been caused by re-phasing of projects.
- 7.2 The current budget is £133.996M, made up of £53.037M Supported Borrowing, £80.025M Prudential Borrowing, £792K funded from Current Revenue and £142K Grant Funding. The Current Projection is £133.996M.
