PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER - BELHAVEN Subject:

STREET BRIDGE, PORT GLASGOW (7.5 TONNE WEIGHT

RESTRICTION REVOCATION) ORDER 2009

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 Local Authorities are empowered to make Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and under the Council's Scheme of Administration the Head of Environmental Services is responsible for the making, implementation and review of Traffic Management Orders and Traffic Regulation Orders.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 At the meeting of The Inverciyde Council held on 28 March 2002, the Council agreed to make the Traffic Regulation Order - Belhaven Street Bridge, Port Glasgow (7.5 Tonne Weight Restriction) Order 2002.
- 2.2 The bridge has been replaced with a new structure and the 7.5 Tonne weight restriction is no longer necessary. Accordingly, it is proposed to revoke the Traffic Regulation Order which imposes the restriction.
- 2.3 The Safe, Sustainable Communities Committee, at the meeting held on 1 September 2009, agreed that The Inverclyde Council be asked to make a Traffic Regulation Order to revoke the 7.5 tonne weight restriction on Belhaven Street Bridge, Port Glasgow in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and associated Regulations.
- 2.4 The proposals have been advertised and no objections have been received

3.0 RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 That a Resolution is made in the following terms.
- 3.2 THE INVERCLYDE COUNCIL, incorporated under the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994, RESOLVE TO MAKE as they HEREBY MAKE a Resolution under Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to permit revocation of the 7.5 tonne weight restriction on Belhaven Street Bridge, Port Glasgow all as detailed in a copy of the Order forming a supplement to the principal minute hereof, and that the Appendix Head of Environmental Services and Head of Legal & Administration be authorised to take all necessary action in connection therewith.
