Subject: PROPOSED POLLING SCHEME - INVERCLYDE COUNTY

CONSTITUENCY

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to ask Members to delegate authority to the Returning Officer to (i) enter into a consultation exercise in relation to the Polling Scheme to be adopted for forthcoming elections; (ii) finalise the Polling Scheme in consultation with local members; and (iii) make any further alterations which may be required to the Polling Scheme prior to the date of the General Election.

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The current Polling Scheme was approved by the Council, on 4 December 2008.
- 2.2 Two of the Polling Places identified within the Polling Scheme will no longer be available to the Returning Officer for future elections. These Polling Places are (a) St Lawrence's Primary School which is due to close in February 2010; and (b) Ravenscraig Primary School which is due to close in February 2010.
- 2.3 It is proposed that those electors who currently vote at St Lawrence's Primary School should be accommodated at St Lawrence's Social Club, Cartsburn Street, Greenock. The members of the Club have been consulted and are more than happy to allow the Club to be used. Those electors who currently vote at Ravenscraig Primary School should be accommodated at the new Aileymill Primary School which is due to open when Ravenscraig Primary School closes.
- 2.4 It is not proposed to alter the number of Polling Places, which will remain at 37.
- 2.5 The timetable for the review is as detailed in Appendix 1.

3.0 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 It is recommended that the Council delegate authority to the Returning Officer to (i) enter into a consultation exercise in relation to the Polling Scheme to be adopted for forthcoming elections; (ii) finalise the Polling Scheme in consultation with local members; and (iii) make any further alterations which may be required to the Polling Scheme prior to the date of the General Election.

4.0 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 In terms of the Representation of the People Act 1983, as amended by the Electoral Administration Act 2006, the Council is required to consult with stakeholders in regard to any proposed changes to its Polling Scheme for elections.
- 4.2 The Chief Executive is the Returning Officer for all elections.
- 4.3 The Council last updated its Polling Scheme on 4 December 2008. Since that date a number of alterations have taken place which necessitate a review of the Polling Scheme. These alterations relate to (a) St Lawrence's Primary School which is due to be demolished in February 2010; and (b) Ravenscraig Primary School which is due to close February 2010.

5.0 PROPOSALS

- 5.1 The proposed alterations to the Polling Scheme are:
 - (a) the current Polling Place at St Lawrence's Primary School be replaced with St Lawrence's Social Club, Cartsburn Street, Greenock; and (b) the current Polling Place at Ravenscraig Primary School be replaced by Aileymill Primary School, Auchmead Road, Greenock.
- 5.2 The proposed Polling Scheme applies the Council's general policy of avoiding the use of cabins which are regarded as inadequate for staff and electors as well as presenting security implications. Cabins may require to be utilised in an emergency situation, where for example a Polling Place becomes unavailable through fire or flood.
- 5.3 As part of the consultation exercise, the Returning Officer will seek the views of Inverclyde Council on Disability (ICOD).
- 5.4 To accommodate changes which may occur between the date of approval of the Polling Scheme and the date of the Election, it is recommended, as is customary, that the Chief Executive, in his role as Returning Officer be delegated the power to make any necessary alterations to the Polling Scheme.

6.0 IMPLICATIONS

6.1 Legal

The Council is required to put in place a Polling Scheme to accommodate those entitled to vote in the forthcoming General Election.

6.2 Financial

The costs associated with the Polling Scheme and providing the Polling Places and Polling Stations are fully recoverable from the Scotland Office.

6.3 Equality

All of the Polling Places identified are either fully accessible to disabled electors or will be provided with temporary ramps.

Specifically the Council requires to review the arrangements in respect of those electors who currently vote at:

- (a) St Lawrence's Primary School; and
- (b) Ravenscraig Primary School.

The Council would welcome any comments from electors who are registered within the above parliamentary constituency and those persons or bodies who have particular expertise in relation to premises or facilities for persons with any type of disability. Representations should, if possible, suggest alternative arrangements to be considered.
