Subject: Childcare Strategy and Surestart Funding

## 1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide information on the use of Childcare Strategy and Surestart funding to voluntary and private providers.

## 2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 Ladybird Pre-5 Centre and Tree Tops Community Nursery have received annual Surestart and Childcare Strategy funding since 2001.
- 2.3 This funding has been allocated to provide placements for vulnerable children under 3.
- 2.4 The report proposes a new system for the allocation of this funding which allows vulnerable children to be placed in their local establishment and adheres to procurement advice.
- 2.5 The Heads of Ladybird Pre-5 Centre and Tree Tops Community Nursery have been consulted on this proposal.

#### 4.0 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 Ladybird Pre-5 Centre and Tree Tops Community Nursery have received annual Surestart and Childcare Strategy funding since 2001.
- 4.2 The funding has remained at the same level since 2001:

	Surestart	Childcare Strategy
Ladybird Pre-5 Centre	£16,000	£27,000
Tree Tops Community Nursery	£16,000	£25,000

- 4.3 This funding is for the provision for nursery placements for vulnerable children under 3. This includes children on the child protection register, 'looked after' children, children with health and / or developmental problems, and children from families where there is substance misuse or domestic violence issues.
- 4.4 Children are referred for a nursery place by a professional agency e.g., Social Work, Health, Psychological Services.

#### 5.0 CURRENT PROCESS

- 5.1 Committee approval was granted in 2001 for annual funding to be allocated to Ladybird Pre-5 Centre and Tree Tops Community Nursery.
- 5.2 Currently the funding to Ladybird Pre-5 Centre buys the equivalent of 6.2 full-time equivalent places and the funding to Tree Tops Community Nursery buys the equivalent of 5.8 places.
- 5.3 Due to the changing demographics of areas there is now demand for children to be allocated in Partner establishments in other areas of Inverclyde.

#### 6.0 PROPOSAL FOR 2010 / 2011

- 6.1 It is proposed that the £84,000 currently allocated to Ladybird Pre-5 Centre and Tree Tops Community Nursery is made available to all Partner establishments.
- 6.2 All children will be allocated childcare places through the established Early Years Admissions process.
- 6.3 Currently there are 4 Partner establishments who could offer placements to vulnerable children under 3; however it is likely that the majority of places will remain in Ladybird Pre-5 Centre and Tree Tops Community Nursery.
- 6.4 Children would be allocated a place in their local establishment and funding would be paid according to the type of placement.
- 6.5 Based on the rate that Education Services pays Daycarers to care for the same group of children it is proposed that establishments would be paid £14.00 for a ½ day session and £28.00 for a full day session.
- 6.6 The current funding of £84,000 would allow the equivalent of 12 full-time places to be purchased annually. This would meet current demand.

## 7.0 CONSULTATION

7.1 The Heads of Ladybird Pre-5 Centre and Tree Tops Community Nursery have been consulted with.

7.2 Both Heads of Centre fully agree with the proposal.
