1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to give details of applications received for consideration for funding from the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Budget in 2011/12.

.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The Budget for the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Fund for 2011/12 is £216,530. Following round 1 grant decisions £120,530 remains to be allocated.
- 2.2 Details of the grants applications received for Round 2 are given in Appendix A. In total 79 grant applications have been received with the total sum requested being £465,366. Further information on each application is available on request and will also be available at the Committee meeting.
- 2.3 Two requests have been received for a variation in grant awards. One local organisation which is closing down on 30 November 2011 has requested advice on what proportion of their yearly grant should be returned. Another, Royal Gourock Yacht Club, have requested that a variation in grants be awarded, see Appendix B.
- 2.4 A number of applicants who were awarded grants in round 1 have not yet submitted their 'End of Year' grant return. Efforts are being made to contact them and to finalise payments. Any grants outstanding on 8 December will be advised to Committee for decision.

3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 3.1 It is recommended that the Grants Sub-Committee considers:
 - 1. the level of funding to be allocated to the projects in Appendix A;

2. requests for variation in grant awards; and

3. action to be taken where organisations have not submitted their 'End of Year' return.'

Grants to RGYC.

In confirmation of our telephone conversations 27th October and earlier dealing with two grants of £500 made to RGYC relating to our youth and adult training programmes..

Grant form dated February 2011 relating to Topper dinghies. £500 awarded and paid to RGYC account.

Grant form dated May 2011 relating to Piper sails. £500 awarded and not paid.

As explained to you the Topper dinghies were eventually purchased and donated to the Club by a group of generous members. Therefore, we withdraw this grant application and are prepared to refund the award. The second grant of £500 has not been paid pending closure of the first grant by the Club. It is proposed, for simplicity, that the £500 received relating to the Topper grant is reallocated on your records to the Piper sails grant.

In effect we have reduced the total award to the Club, under these two grant requests from £1000 to £500. As the original Piper sails request was for a much larger sum, I am resubmitting the Piper sails application and requesting that the Grants Committee consider increasing the award to £1000.
