Subject: Round 2 Applications 2012-13

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to give details of applications received for consideration for funding from the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Budget in 2012-13.

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The Budget for the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Fund for 2012-2013 is £198,530. At their Meeting on 28 June 2012, the Grants Sub-committee allocated £73,600 to successful applicants in Round 1. The balance remaining for distribution is £124,930.
- 2.2 Details of the grant applications received for Round 2 are given in Appendix A. In total, 49 grant applications have been received, with the total sum requested being £203,231.98. Further information on each application is available on request and will also be available at the Committee meeting.
