1.0 PURPOSE

- 1.1 To submit the CHCP's quarterly Governance report to the CHCP sub-committee for information and to update the Sub-Committee on progress in terms of the governance process.
- 1.2 The key focus of the CHCP Governance arrangements is to ensure that contracted services maintain quality service provision and meet financial governance requirements.

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The Policy & Resources Committee agreed in May 2011 to introduce a process to ensure that the Council fulfils its overall Governance responsibilities towards external organisations effectively.
- 2.2 The majority of organisations on the Council's governance list deliver services for the CHCP.
- 2.3 The CHCP sub–committee in October 2012 agreed the CHCP Governance procedures and reporting format. CHCP Governance reports are to be submitted within each committee cycle.
- 2.4 The new arrangements require Joint Governance meetings to take place on a prioritised basis with 72 organisations on either a quarterly or six monthly basis.
- 2.5 The CHCP Governance reports will provide information to Committee which meets the Councils Governance requirements.

3.0 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 That the Inverclyde CHCP Sub-Committee note the CHCP Governance report (Appendix 1).

4.0 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 The report approved by the ICHCP Sub-Committee in October 2012 detailed that the CHCP required to meet with 72 of the Council's 77 external contracted services.
- 4.2 The report provided detailed information on the schedule of joint governance meetings which require to be conducted by the CHCP between 1 September 2012 and 31 March 2013. The CHCP's first governance report was included profiling performance information and the arrangements for formal Joint Governance Meetings with Organisations, Senior Commissioning and Contracts Officers and Finance Services.
- 4.3 Finance Services have provided significant input within the CHCP governance process which has included attendance at Governance meetings as required and discussing matters relating to the Organisation's financial position. Financial information has been provided systematically to both Commissioning and Contracts Officers regarding the financial status of Organisations which, if required, has resulted in further engagement with the Organisation by Finance Services to ensure financial governance requirements have been achieved.
- 4.4 A key focus of the governance process is quality of service. Quality of service is monitored via various levels of scrutiny ranging from individual care reviews; contract monitoring and Care Inspectorate grading. Services which have received high Care Inspectorate Grades and positive contract monitoring reports are acknowledged within the governance reporting process. Services which receive low care inspectorate grades invoke a contract management process involving CHCP Contracts Officers liaising with the Care Inspectorate and the Provider to ensure that the action plan for improvement meets our expectations in terms of contract compliance. In particular, if the grade relates to quality of care and support, CHCP commissioners and contracts officers actively monitor progress to ensure timeous resolution and to inform any contingency planning arrangements that may be required from a CHCP perspective.
- 4.5 The National Care Home Contract for Older People applies a financial penalty (£20 per resident per week) in the following circumstances:-
 - A Care Home receiving a grade of 2 or less in the theme of Quality Care and Support and has not previously been at grade 2 or below, the Care Home is given the opportunity to correct this via an improvement plan agreed with the Care Inspectorate. The Care Home will not normally be subject to the penalty unless it fails to recover a grade 3 or above at the next inspection; and
 - A Care Home receiving a grade of 2 or less in the area of Quality of Care and Support, and has previously been graded at this level, the penalty deduction will apply.
- 4.6 The final decision as to whether reductions are applied is at the discretion of the CHCP.
- 4.7 The Scottish Government's proposals for the integration of adult health and social care explain that each Health and Social Care Partnership will be expected to produce a Joint Commissioning Plan for Older Peoples services. Inverclyde CHCP has produced an overarching commissioning strategy for all services from which a commissioning delivery plan for each service area will be developed.
- 4.8 Crucial to the commissioning and planning process is the involvement of third and independent sector providers. The CHCP Governance report demonstrates the link between the commissioned service and the commissioning plans. For example, the CHCP Joint Commissioning Plan for Older Peoples Services directly relates to the Change Fund Plan.
- 4.9 Inverclyde Council is the first Local Authority area in Scotland to participate in the Partners for Change (PFC) process. PFC is delivered by the Social Value Lab and partners as part of the national Developing Markets for the Third Sector Providers Programme.
- 4.10 The PFC process has produced a Commissioning Improvement Plan which involves the third and independent sector more fully in service planning. The process has linked specifically to the CHCP Joint Commissioning Strategy.

5.0 PROPOSALS

- 5.1 To note that the CHCP has conducted 42 Joint Governance Meetings during the reporting period October December 2012 with a focus on quality of service; relationship to the CHCP joint commissioning strategy and financial governance requirements.
- 5.2 To note that the Joint Governance process has provided enhanced performance and financial governance information as detailed in Appendix One of this report.
- 5.3 That the Governance Report to the CHCP sub-committee in February will complete the CHCP's reporting requirements in respect of the CHCP's 72 external organisations. (A further 30 joint governance meetings)
- 5.4 That future CHCP governance meetings continue to be prioritised according to financial and contract monitoring status and governance reporting requirements.
