Subject: Round 2 Applications 2014 – 2015

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this report is to give details of applications received for consideration for funding from the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Budget in 2014-2015.

2.0 SUMMARY

- 2.1 The budget for the Grants to Voluntary Organisations Fund for 2014-2015 is £331,430. Earmarked reserves to the value of £57,000 have been carried forward from the last financial year. From this total of £388,430, £163,917 was awarded in Round 1, leaving £224,513 available for Round 2. The budget will reduce to £281,430 in 2015-2016.
- 2.2 Following a review of GTVO processes and procedures, a registration process has been introduced for all applicants. There are now 3 types of application:-
 - One off;
 - 3 year grants under £5,000; and
 - 3 year grants of £5,000 and over.

Details of the grant applications received are given in Appendix A. In total, 75 grant applications have been received with the total sum requested being £457,347.18 per annum. These comprise the following:-

• One off grants 22 applications totalling £52,736;

3 year grants under £5,000
3 year grants £5,000 and over
13 applications totalling £24,539 per annum; and
10 applications totalling £87,367 per annum.

Please note that a number of application forms were unclear about the level of funding requested over the 3 year period. This may necessitate some minor amendments to Appendix 1. Further information on each application is available on request and will also be available at the Committee meeting.

2.3 Eight applications to the value of £32,535 were deferred from Round 1. These are listed in Appendix B. The majority of these were sports organisations for whom the impact of changes to the waivers policy had not been determined.

2.4 Four late applications for summer playschemes, each requesting £5,000, were received outwith the funding cycle. These were approved by the Convener and are listed in Appendix C

3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 3.1 It is recommended that the Grants Sub-Committee:
- 3.2 (1) consider the level of funding to be allocated to the organisations in Appendix A
- 3.3 (2) consider the level of funding to be allocated to applications deferred from Round 1 as listed in Appendix B; and
- 3.4 (3) retrospectively endorse allocation of funding for summer playschemes as detailed in Appendix C.
